We are saddened to have just received word that we have lost a talented member of CPC. Gunnar N. passed away unexpectedly last week, leaving behind his wife and two children. A graduate of the Film Industry Training Program at Norwalk Community College, Gunnar was a friend to many in the business here in the state. Below is his obituary as it read in Sunday's Norwich Bulletin.

Gunnar N. June 13, 1974 - August 13, 2009 Norwich - Gunnar N. 35, formerly Nordberg of Ripley pace died unexpectedly Thursday at his home in Norwich, CT. He was born in Woodbury, New Jersey on June 13, 1974. Son of Gunnar and Linda (DeMarco) Nordberg of Buena, NJ. Gunnar served his country honorably in the United States Army as a Military Policeman and later, performed Military Funeral Honors. Gunnar worked many careers which included Sound Technician/ Boom-Man for Independant film companies, Recording Artist, Musician, Mixed Media Artist, Poet/Writer, Autism Awareness Advocate, Founder of the Saintronic Church, an online database for knowledge of all belief systems, Darks Pandemonium, a solo musical visual/ performance art project, which can be seen on Youtube and Myspace, various supervisor positions, and childcare worker/managing coordinator at a youth group home. In addition, Gunnar also held a PHD in Religions and was an ordained Minister. On October 31, 1999 he was united in marriage to his best friend and soul-mate Janet Elaine Hamilton in Scranton, PA. Mrs. N. survives her husband. He is also survived by his children Gareth Orion N., 10, and Vanien Nathaniel N., 3 of Norwich, His parents Gunnar and Linda Nordberg, his sister Carrie Lynn Mason of Vineland, NJ, his father in law Clifford Hamilton, Brothers in law George Mason, Lee Peck, Cliff Hamilton, Duane Hamilton, who he loved as his own brother, several nieces and nephews, and many friends whose lives he touched in profound ways.
